THE PLAYERS' VOICE

The PCA Players' Committee has the responsibility to vote on all issues affecting the PCA membership, including collective agreements.

The Committee comprises of a representative from each professional male and female squad and meets regularly to discuss ongoing and future challenges that face the membership.

Led by the PCA Chair, the group is represented on key professional game working groups whilst also being the voice for the Association in their dressing room by actively promoting aims and objectives for the benefit of players.

The PCA Women's Committee was also created in 2021, holding exclusive voting rights on issues relating specifically to the female game.

REPRESENTING YOUR RIGHTS

The PCA delivers extensive support with all contractual issues and enquiries, as well as representing the players in discussions with the ECB and professional counties.

The PCA's Cricket Department manages individual and collective representation, including player-wide agreements through to individual disciplinary and dispute hearings.

The team also oversees the day-to-day operations of the Team England partnerships.

Negotiator Service:

- Guidance and support on contractual matters.
- The PCA will attend meetings with club officials to help you negotiate on your terms.

Collective Rights:

The PCA explores new ventures such as data led projects and commercial opportunities.

EMPOWERING ENGLAND INTERNATIONALS

The PCA works closely with the Team England Player Partnership (TEPP) and England Women's Player Partnership (EWPP) to ensure the needs of professional England cricketers are met and their rights protected.

Inducting new members of the partnerships, the PCA helps to reduce distractions and allows players to focus on representing their country on the field.

- TEPP/EWPP plays a central role in the negotiation of collective agreements relating to the contracts, employment terms and commercial rights of the players.
- PCA manages and delivers the England player commercial programme with ECB partners including managing appearances, image rights and licensing.

Key aspects of the PDWP

- A programme delivered through one-to-one coaching and mentoring that is designed to empower individuals to excel within the professional cricketing environment and transition to fulfilling lives beyond the game.
- Delivered by people who care about your life in and away from the game, who understand the challenges of high performance sport and who can provide confidential support and independent guidance without judgement.

Development courses

Take advantage of various personal development courses delivered one-to-one, or to your squad. Enrol on flagship events such as Rookie Camp, Futures Conference and access additional funding opportunities through the Futures Awards.

PCA Learning Platform

Accessed through your unique log-in to thepca.co.uk, the PCA Learning Platform provides free access to tailored personal development and welfare content, short certificated courses and a range of useful resources.

EDUCATION AND TRAINING FUNDING

The aim of education funding is to provide financial assistance to current and former players to support their personal development plans through educational and career development opportunities.

From 1 April 2026, education funding has increased to provide greater financial assistance to current and former players to support their personal development plans.

The PCA will fund 50% of individual personal development courses of up to £2,000 per member, and £2,500 for PCA Reps, per year.

Coaching Qualifications



The PCA will fund ECB coaching courses upon successful completion.

Fully funded: ECB Core Coach and ECB Advanced Coach.

Part funded: ECB Specialist Coach.

The PCA runs wide-ranging Futures initiatives which aim to highlight the importance of preparing for life outside of professional cricket, whether it's during or after a player's career. Including a tailored Future Careers manual, you can also access:

Futures Awards
